Practicum description: OTA Orthopedics, stroke, general medicine; has had exposure to SLP.

Clinical: GRASP program, PROM of upper extremities (independent), works with patient with Alzheimer's doing GRASP – requires challenging communication. Has been following Frances in ortho and will doing some ADLs for TKR and THR patients

Technical: has been doing set up of wheelchairs with 2- and 4-point belts. Knows about cushions. Sets up chairs and delivers to patients

Operational: typed out sign out sheet for interpreters; orders the masks and PPE for PT, OT, SLP; prints up census for OTs
